***Budget***

***Wilton Drive Trash Pickup***

Member Dreger commented that in his walks on Wilton Drive it is clear that the Emerald Irish contract worker is doing an excellent job, and the addition of the temporary trash cans on the Drive are making a big difference.

***Mural at 2000 Wilton Drive***

Member Dreger gave a status update on the mural. Ms. Wald gave an opinion on the potential for perceived conflict to Member Hugo, since he volunteered his wall to be used for the WDID Board's use.

**Member Hugo offered the following disclosure:**

**As the owner of the business at 2000 Wilton Drive, I am donating the use of the south face wall for a mural to be used for City purposes, and in an abundance of caution, understanding that the mural may be considered a private gain or loss to ownership of the business, I am disclosing the same on the record and abstaining from voting on the issue.**



Upon my return home from my travel, I will complete Form 8B and request it be made part of the official minutes.

After discussion, the Board decided to defer action on the mural to the March or April meeting.

***Photospot***

Member Dreger gave a status update on the Public Art Committee's efforts on the photospot.

***Wilton Drive Construction***

Vice Chair Blevins mentioned the recent editorial by Norm Kent in the SFGN about the Wilton Drive construction. He wanted the Board to know he intends to write a rebuttal as an individual resident, not as the Vice Chair of the WDID. He also mentioned that his discussions and observations of the larger Wilton Drive businesses is that not many are suffering.

***Jaycee Park***

Chair LoGrande requested the Jaycee Park redesign rendering be added to the city website and wiltondrive.org as an visual example of future vision. He also asked that the design information be provided to the Board at the March meeting, and discuss official support of the plan.

***Parking***

Member LoGrande offered a discussion of parking on Wilton Drive. Discussion ensued.




