RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING CONTAINERS:

Every new resident will receive one green recycling roll-out cart. Please put all your recyclables in this cart and place the cart by the curb on your recycling day.

RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTER:

You may also bring your recyclables to the drop-off center which is located on the southeast corner of NE 24th Street and NE 12th Avenue.

RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE CONTAINERS:

All single-family residents will receive a 96 gallon garbage cart. By 7:00 a.m. on your collection day, this cart must be placed within five (5) feet of the street. It is important to always have the cart facing the street (i.e., the handles are located on the side closest to your residence). In addition to their 96 gallon cart, residents may place either (a) one additional bag of trash not exceeding forty (40) pounds in weight; or (b) one bundle of branches not exceeding four (4) feet in length and forty (40) pounds in weight.

Residential customers who are physically disabled or mentally challenged and are unable to place rollout garbage carts at the curb, may request side-door service. Additionally, residential customers who are sixty-five (65) years or older may request to use a smaller sixty-five (65) gallon garbage cart. The City may require sufficient documentation to determine eligibility for side-door service and the use of smaller sixty-five (65) gallon carts.

BULK GARBAGE:

Bulk items may be placed at the curb up to twenty-four (24) hours before your scheduled pick-up date. All items must be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled bulk pick-up day to ensure pick-up. Bulk trash includes items such as furniture, appliances and other materials not suitable for normal loading into packer-type vehicles. Bulk collection is not intended for hazardous chemical waste; automobile parts; major construction debris; or trash resulting from commercial landscaping or lawn service transported to a residential unit from elsewhere.

For safety reasons, all mirrors, glass tabletops, window panes, and plate glass must be placed within an additional rigid container. These types of glass represent a serious threat of injury to the employees of Waste Management and will not be picked up unless properly stored. Please contact us for a complete list of bulk rules.
