On February 1, 2016 at approximately 5:00 AM, the Wilton Manors Police Department responded to a burglary to a business which had just occurred at the Bubbles Laundry located at 2605 N. Andrews Avenue. Upon arrival, police officers observed ceiling tiles leading from the main portion of the business into the locked office area broken and on the floor.

The business was checked and it was determined that the suspect had already left prior to police arriving on scene. Detectives were able to obtain surveillance video from the business. The suspect can be seen walking back and forth in the business for more than thirty minutes with plastic containers trying to figure out how to get high enough so he could climb over the wall and into the locked office. One of the attempts caused him to slip and fall as he was climbing up. The suspect was so determined; he continued to rig up different items until he was finally able to get up and over into the locked office.

Although the suspect looked around the office for money, he found a cash box, but found himself leaving with nothing of value. As the suspect made his way back out of the office via the ceiling tiles, he falls and gets tangled up in some wires. The suspect is then seen running from the business in an unknown direction.

The suspect is a black male wearing a brown shirt and possibly brown pants. He has what appears to be either a scar or tattoo on his right cheek. Wilton Manors Police ask anyone who recognizes the suspect from the video to contact Broward County Crime Stoppers at 954-493-8477(TIPS).
