FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

On March 05, 2016 shortly after 6:00 AM, the Wilton Manors Police Department (WMPD) responded to a delayed burglary to a business which occurred at the Texaco Gas Station located at 2425 Wilton Drive. Upon arrival, Officers observed a hole that had been cut into the wall leading into the office of the business.

The business was checked and it was determined that the suspect had already left prior to police arriving on scene. Officers were able to obtain surveillance video from the business. The video shows the suspect eventually entered the main store where he is seen walking back and forth opening up cabinet drawers and grabbing money out of the cash register. The suspect then returned to the office, exiting the building through the same entry hole, and leaving in an unknown direction.

The suspect is a white male approximately in his late forties to fifties, medium build, dark hair, possibly wearing a dark green colored hoodie sweatshirt, grey shorts, gloves on his hands, white socks, and black and grey sneakers.
