(Wilton Manors, FL) - On April 13, 2016 at approximately 11:05 AM, the Wilton Manors Police Department (WMPD) received a report of a Strong Armed Robbery which had just occurred in front of Publix, located at 100 W. Oakland Park Blvd, Wilton Manors. The victim (HELDRI TEES) had just taken some money out of her wallet and handed it to her daughter so she could purchase something inside Publix. As the victim began placing her wallet back into her purse, the suspect approached the victim and snatched her wallet. The robbery suspect and three other subjects ran through the parking lot while being chased by a witness. The witness chased the subjects for a couple of blocks until they entered the residential area off of N. Andrews Ave. where she lost sight of them.

WMPD units immediately responded and setup a perimeter. Two subjects fitting the description given to police were detained. Both the victim and witness were able to positively identify both the culprit who snatched the wallet and the second subject as one of the three individuals who was standing around when the robbery occurred. The two suspects were arrested and transferred to the Broward County Juvenile Intake Facility. Due to their ages, the suspect's names will not be released.

The other two subjects were never located and are still wanted for questioning in this incident. They are described as both being black male teenagers, 5 foot 6 inches to 5 foot 8 inches, with short hair.
