FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

On March 14, 2017 at approximately 5:30 PM, Wilton Manors Police Department responded to the Tech Pro Repair shop located at 62 E Oakland Park BLVD in reference to a disturbance between the store clerk and a customer. When police arrived, the store clerk/victim (Mansur Sabirdjanov) advised the following:

An unidentified B/M customer entered the store and asked for repairs to be done on an IPHONE. The clerk/victim stated he completed the repairs, but the male refused to pay and wanted his phone back. The clerk/victim stated that he stepped outside of the store to call the police and left the customer inside. While the clerk/victim was outside calling the police, the customer began looking for his cellphone inside the business. The suspect was captured on surveillance video going through the clerk/victim's wallet which is located in the back of the business in an area where only employees are allowed and stole money. The customer is then observed taking money out of the business' cash register and begins to leave.

As the customer attempts to leave the store an altercation ensues between the customer and the clerk/victim. The victim was able to retrieve a portion of the money taken. The customer left the business without his cellphone and was last seen walking northbound on foot. The suspect is described as a black male, 5'7" – 5'9", short black hair, and is believed to be 16 – 18 years of age.
