## South Florida tops in the 'Best of Gay Cities' awards

outh Florida won several "Best of Gay Cities" Awards from Q.Digital, a media company focused on the LGBTQ community.

The San Francisco-based company operates GayCities.com, a location-based social network for things to do, as well as Queerty.com, a news and entertainment site.
